## TIRE PRESSURE ON TRACTORS

Sure is getting hot! With warmer weather, we will experience warmer pavement temperatures. With warmer temperatures, we will experience warmer tire temperatures. Heat is a tire's worst enemy! No one likes to check air pressure in tires but it is VITAL to the life of a tire to have the correct air pressure. M&M Cartage gives every new driver a tire gauge for this exact reason. Keeping tires aired up keeps you off the shoulder of the road. Almost all tire failures are caused by under inflation, meaning that you can prevent help prevent tire failure by simply checking the air pressure during your pre trip inspection. We use flow through valve caps that allow you to check tire pressure without removing the cap. It is critical to check your tire pressure. Below is are the correct tire pressure levels. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

- Tractors: Steer tires -110 PSI Driver tires 100 PSI
- Trailers: 100 PSI or 125 PSI (FOR DROP DECKS ONLY)

#### PRE-TRIP AIR TANK DRAINING

All drivers should be draining their air tanks every day as part of your pre trip inspection, even in the summer time. Water takes up capacity and also causes rust which will lead to bigger issues with the braking/air system. With M&M having more and more trucks with automatic transmissions, these transmissions are using air to assist with the shifting more than ever. PLEASE DRAIN YOUR AIR TANKS DAILY. If you are unsure where all the drains are, please see the shop.

### **ELD HOURS OF SERVICE VIOLATIONS**

Anyone with an hours of service violation will have to complete remedial training in RMC (online monthly training portal). You will be assigned "Hours of Service for CMV Drivers" training assignment and a deadline to complete it by. ## ATTENTION ALL DRIVERS AND CDL HOLDERS
