CALL OFF PROCEDURE

TROUBLE WITH TRUCKS NOT STARTING

We are seeing more and more instances of trucks being written up for no starts on the Louisville and Sharonville yard. Many of our trucks have a battery shut off switch (see pictures below) on the floor next to the driver's seat.
